## Swedish Consumer Agency's estimates

## All meals made at home

All meals for both children and adults are made at home, based on the Swedish Consumer Agency's new menu. This is a four-week basic menu. The menu includes breakfast, lunch, dinner and two snacks. The menu is available on the Swedish Consumer Agency's website.

## All meals except weekday

 lunches are made at home Lunch five days a week has been subtracted from the cost. Children eat at school. You have to add the cost of your lunches.
## Clothes and shoes

Basic needs of clothes and shoes for everyday use, for leisure activities and more festive occasions. This also includes accessories such as bags, watches and umbrellas.

## Leisure

Common leisure activities, toys, books, skis, a bicycle, membership fees etc.

## Mobile phone

The cost of purchasing a mobile phone.

## Personal hygiene

Applies to things like soap, toothpaste, sanitary products, haircuts and an annual visit to the dentist (examination) for adults.

## Insurance for children

 and young peopleCost of accident and health insurance that also covers leisure activities.

## Equipment for infants and young children

 Items such as pram, cot, bedding, changing table and car seat.
## Household goods

Items such as washingand cleaning products, toilet paper, paper towels etc.

## Furniture and

 household itemsFurniture, household utensils, TV, computer, tablet etc. Appliances such as dishwashers and washing machines are not included.

## Media

Costs for broadband, mobile phone subscriptions, streaming services, daily newspaper etc.

## Electricity

Does not include heating.

## Water

Water usage in the home that is provided by the municipality.

## Home insurance

The cost of a home insurance varies depending on the amount insured and your location.
